H 1159. MILITARY EXPIRATION OF DRIVERS LICENSE. Intro. 4/10/03. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Adds new GS 20-7(r) to provide that licensee who is member of National Guard or Reserves is exempt from required eye exam when renewing license if, at time of renewal, licensee is serving in combat or qualified hazardous duty zone.

H 1159. MILITARY EXPIRATION OF DRIVERS LICENSE. Intro. 4/10/03. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Rewrites amendment to GS 20-7. Only substantive change is new provision that license renewed by mail under GS 20-7(q) is a permanent license and does not expire when license holder returns to NC. Adds amendments to GS 20-30.1(e) and -39.1(g) to add agents of the Dep't of Defense to the list of those eligible for confidential license plates and for license plates issued under assumed names, using false or fictitious addresses.
