H 1167. SESSION LIMITS. TO LIMIT SESSION LENGTH BY LIMITING THE NUMBER OF DAYS OF PER DIEM PAID TO MEMBERS. Adds new GS 120-3.1(e) and (f) as title indicates, discontinuing the subsistence and travel allowance if the General Assembly has been in regular session more than 135 calendar days during odd-numbered years, and more than 60 days in even-numbered years, except that period may be extended by joint resolution once per session, for up to ten days. Subsection (g) excludes sessions reconvened under Art. III, Sec. 5 of NC Constitution from act's requirements.
