H 1182. OSHA TECH. CHANGES/FATALITY PENALTY (NEW). Intro. 4/10/03. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Reorganizes GS 95-138 and makes other technical changes. Amends GS 95-138 to apply penalties established for willful violations to repeat violations. Replaces former GS 95-138(a1), which imposed penalty for actual negligence or continued maintenance of unsafe condition resulting in death of employee, with provision imposing penalty for each willful or repeat violation resulting in death of employee, and clarifies that penalty is in lieu of penalty imposed by GS 95-138(a)(1).
