H 1221. RETURN OVERPAYMENTS OF STATE FUNDS. REQUIRING THE RETURN OF OVERPAYMENTS OF STATE FUNDS BY PERSONS IN STATE-SUPPORTED POSITIONS. Adds new Art. 3H to GS Ch. 143, entitled Overpayment of State Funds. Requires any person in a state-funded position who receives an overpayment of state funds, in the form of salary or otherwise, to repay the funds. Provides that the amount of the overpayment may be offset against the person's salary, to the extent allowed by law. Prohibits state-funded entities from forgiving repayment of an overpayment and requires them to pursue repayment by all lawful means. Effective when it becomes law and applicable to overpayments of state funds made on or after that date.

Deletes provision prohibiting a state department, agency, or institution, or other state-funded entity, from seeking repayment of an overpayment of state funds if either (1) the costs of pursuing repayment will exceed the amount of overpayment, or (2) three or more years have elapsed since the time of overpayment.
