TO EXPAND THE OPTION FOR LARGE COUNTIES TO FUND AND PROVIDE LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS AND CONCERNING LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF MECKLENBURG COUNTY. Deletes GS 153A-301(a)(10)b. and c., which required that county have an interlocal agreement with a city and pay a certain percentage of city budget before creating law enforcement county service district. Increases total population required to establish law enforcement service district to 650,000 (was, 500,000). Amends SL 1969, Ch. 1170, Sec. 1, to provide that police in any municipality in Mecklenburg County (was, Charlotte) may exercise authority in certain unincorporated areas of the County. Effective Jan. 1, 2005.
