**H 1344. HIGHWAY TRUST FUND CHANGES.** *TO AMEND THE HIGHWAY TRUST FUND TO DEFINE THE INTRASTATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM OF THE STATE AND TO MAKE THE INTRASTATE SYSTEM ELIGIBLE FOR HIGHWAY TRUST FUNDS.* Amends GS 136-175(1) to redefine "intrastate system" as network of major, multilane arterial highways composed of those routes, segments, or corridors listed in GS 136-178 and any other route added by Dep't of Transportation under GS 136-178. Amends GS 136-178 to describe specific route segments or corridors for which funds may be allocated from trust fund for intrastate system. Amends GS 136-182 to delete provision concerning when supplement for secondary road construction must be discontinued

**H 1344. HIGHWAY TRUST FUND CHANGES.** Intro. 5/10/04. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Prior version amended GS 136-178 to provide that funds allocated from the Trust Fund for the Interstate System may be used for projects on listed route segments or corridors. Committee substitute provides that funds are primarily intended to be used to complete projects listed in GS 136-179 and if funds cannot be so used, then they may be used for projects on the listed route segments or corridors. Makes some changes to the listed route segments and corridors.

**H 1344. HIGHWAY TRUST FUND CHANGES.** Intro. 5/10/04. House amendments make the following changes to 2nd edition. (1) Add a provision to GS 136-178 specifying that before DOT encumbers or spends funds on any projects listed in that section (which under the bill's provisions are to be funded only when funds cannot be spent for projects under GS 136-179), it is to report to the legislators representing the counties in which the -179 project is located on the status of the project, the projected date of the project, and the reason for delay in the project. (2) Adds to the GS 136-179 list a new route from US 158 to NC 12 including a new toll bridge over the Currituck sound in Currituck County.
