H 280. 2003 PERMANENT HOUSE RULES. Intro. 3/6/03. House committee substitute adopted 4/29/03 makes the following changes to 1st edition. (1) Amends House Rules 14 and 20(h) to add a motion to recess as fourth in order of motion precedence; (2) Rule 19 to delete provisions allowing the previous question to be called by the majority leader, the Speaker Pro Tem., and the member designated by the Speaker under 26(h) to serve as ex officio member of every committee and permanent subcommittee; (3) Rule 27 to change the name of the Economic Growth and Community Development Committee to the Commerce Committee; (4) Rule 31.1(d) to extend the cross-over deadline from April 26 to May 1; (5) Rule 32(a) to allow the Speaker to calendar a joint resolution or House resolution not reported by a standing committee or permanent subcommittee without first referring it to a committee or subcommittee; and (6) Rule 36.1(a) to require that a request for a fiscal note be allowed when, in the opinion of the Speaker (rather than that of the chair of the committee requesting the note), the fiscal effects of the measure are not apparent from the text of the measure.
