Adds a new subsection to GS 15A-1343 providing that a defendant ordered to submit to a period of residential treatment in the DART program must undergo a screening to determine chemical dependency. If the screening indicates the defendant is chemically dependent, the court must order an assessment to determine the appropriate level of treatment. Repeals GS 15A-1351(h) (substance abuse recommendation). Amends GS 143B-262.1(h) to delete a court recommendation from the admission priorities. Effective December 1, 2003, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
