H 356. FEES (NEW). Intro. 3/10/2004. Senate committee substitute adopted July 1, 2004 makes the following changes to 1st edition. Completely replaces prior edition as follows. Amends GS 84-23, authorizing the Council to regulate State Bar certified paralegals and to charge fees to applicants and participants necessary to administer its certification programs. Amends GS 84-37, authorizing the Council to investigate and act on complaints related to the unauthorized use of various certified paralegal designations. Makes technical and conforming changes. Amends subsection (e) of SL 2003-284 sec. 12.6C (Industrial Comm'n Fees/Computer System Replacement) to provide that the Comm'n may retain authorized fees until the 2009-2011 fiscal biennium. Effective October 1, 2004.
