Rewrites proposed amendment to GS 103-5 to specify that permission to perform legal act on next succeeding business day applies when the public office or courthouse is closed for transactions. Adds similar provision to GS 1A-1 Rule 6, numerous provisions of GS Ch. 45, GS 1-339.64 and -339.25; GS 7B-506, and -1906; GS 105-374; and GS 156-105.
