H 471. CDLCHANGES/MOPED TAG (NEW). Intro. 3/13/03. House committee substitute adds to 2nd edition provisions requiring permanent identification tags on mopeds. Requires moped dealers to attach an approved moped tag to each moped sold in this state and collect a one-time fee of \$25.00 from the purchaser of the new moped. Failure to attach the new tag at the time of sale, and operation of a moped on public streets and highways without displaying the tag, is a Class 3 misdemeanor. Moped tag provisions effective Oct. 1, 2003.
