**H 824. DOT BRIDGE ENCROACHMENTS (NEW).** Intro. 4/1/03. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Rewrites bill to amend GS 136-18 to add new subsection (36) to that section. New subsection authorizes State Board of Transportation to permit private use and encroachment upon highway right-of-way for purpose of building and maintenance of private bridge if the bridge does not interfere with public's use of the highway. Specifies procedure to obtain permit, and allows Board to monitor plans and construction, and inspect it for safety.

**H 824. DOT BRIDGE ENCROACHMENTS.** Intro. 4/1/03. Senate committee substitute adopted 6/9/03 makes the following changes to 3rd edition. (1) Provides that an encroachment agreement authorized by the act may include a requirement to purchase and maintain liability insurance in an amount determined by DOT. (2) The owner of the bridge shall have the bridge inspected every 2 years by a private engineering firm based on National Bridge Inspection Standards and shall provide DOT with copies of the inspection report.
