H 846. ILLEGAL CHILD CARE FACILITIES. TO MAKE IT A FELONY TO KNOWINGLY OPERATE A CHILD CARE FACILITY ILLEGALLY. Rewrites GS 110-103 as follows. Makes it a Class I felony for the operator of a child care facility to provide child care in knowing and willful violation of state child care law or to knowingly and willfully provide child care for more than two children for than four hours per day on two or more consecutive days. Violations following prior conviction and violations creating unreasonable risk of harm to child or resulting in serious injury to child are punished as Class H felony. Section does not apply to persons who, within 24 hours of notification of violation, comply with all applicable laws and rules and child has not been harmed.
