H 893. FIREMEN'S RELIEF FUND REPORTING. TO IMPOSE DEADLINES ON THE REPORT OF FIRE CONDITIONS AND TO PROVIDE THAT UNALLOCATED FUNDS ESCHEAT TO THE GENERAL FUND. Amends GS 58-84-46 to provide that the certificate of eligibility that a city or county with a local board of trustees of the firemen's relief fund must file with the Commissioner of Insurance (Comm'r) by October 31 of each year is to be known as the "Report of Fire Conditions." Provides that if it is not filed by November 30 of that year (now, January 31 of ensuing year) the money is paid over to the state's General Fund (now, if certificate late, money paid into general Firemen's Relief Fund administered by the Comm'r).
