H 943. SCHOOLS CAN'T RECOMMEND SOME MEDICATIONS. *PROHIBITING SCHOOL PERSONNEL FROM RECOMMENDING OR REQUIRING THE USE OF CERTAIN MEDICATIONS BY ANY CHILD.* Amends GS 115C-47(44) requiring that local boards of education implement rules prohibiting school personnel from recommending the use of psychotropic drugs or central nervous system stimulants or requiring use of such drugs as a condition of attending school, except that rules shall not prohibit school personnel from recommending that a child be evaluated by an appropriate medical practitioner or from consulting with a practitioner upon consent of the child's parent or guardian.
