H 969. CONSTIT. AMEND./MAGISTRATES' TERMS. TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION OF NORTH CAROLINA TO CHANGE THE TERM OF OFFICE OF MAGISTRATES. Amends Art. IV, Sec. 10, NC Constitution to establish initial two-year term and subsequent four-year term for magistrates (now all terms are two years). Submits proposed amendment to voters at 2004 general election. Amends GS 7A-171 to make conforming changes to appointment procedure. Provides that four-year term applies to magistrates who have previously been appointed, even if there is a break in service, or if the initial appointment is in a different county. Implementing legislation effective on Jan. 1, 2005, if amendment approved.
