Amends GS 20-218(a) to replace requirement that school bus drivers submit same medical examiner's certificate as is required for holders of commercial drivers licenses with requirement that every two years school bus drivers must submit medical information and undergo a blood pressure check, vision test, and a hearing test. Further provides that upon receipt of this information, school district may require a medical examination to ensure that person is competent to drive a school bus. Makes technical changes.
