Requires nursing home quality assurance committee to implement measures to minimize risk of medication-related errors. Requires nursing home administrators to provide staff training regarding prevention of medication errors. Imposes additional duties on consultant pharmacist. Requires nursing homes to submit annual report on medication errors to Dep't of Health and Human Services. Effective Jan. 1, 2004.
