Changes title to *AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE DMV TO ISSUE A RETIRED HIGHWAY PATROL SPECIAL PLATE TO THE SURVIVING SPOUSES OF RETIRED HIGHWAY PATROLMEN AND TO ISSUE A 4-H SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE AND A HIGH SCHOOL INSIGNIA PLATE. Makes stylistic changes to GS 20-79.4(b)(36a) and adds requirement that surviving spouses of highway patrol retirees be authorized to bear a "SHP, Retired" plate only so long and they renew the plate and do not remarry. Other changes to GS 20-79(b), GS 20-79.7(a) and (b), and GS 20-81.12 as title indicates.*

S 1118. SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES. Intro. 5/17/04. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. (1) Adds to the list of new special registration plates authorized by GS 20-79.4(b) plates for Commercial Fishing, Daughters of the American Revolution, El Pueblo, HOMES4NC, and Sport Fishing. (2) Provides that the money derived from the HOMES4NC plates is to be transferred to the NCAR Housing Opportunity Foundation; from the El Pueblo plates to El Pueblo, Inc. for its scholarship fund for Latino college students; and from the DAR plates to a trust fund to carry out the purposes of the DAR, including historical preservation. (3) Changes the destination of transfer of money from the First in Forestry plates so that half will go to the Division of Forest Resources for a state forests and forestry education program and half to the Forest Education and Conservation Foundation for its programs.
