S 1370. GOLDSBORO SURPLUS LOT DISTRIBUTION. Intro. 5/27/04. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Adds reference to Wayne County in title of act and clarifies that act applies to property jointly owned by Goldsboro and Wayne County. Provides that if dividing substandard lot among adjoining property owners creates two standard lots, ownership of the entire substandard lot will be awarded to the owner of the adjoining lot with the greater degree of substandard condition, not to the highest contiguous bidder as a result of a sealed bid process (as under previous edition). Requires Goldsboro, when selling standard properties, to notify individuals and entities who previously have bid on surplus property and real estate firms. Makes other minor changes in disposal procedures.
