**S 421. AMEND CHILD WELFARE LAWS.** Intro. 3/17/03. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Amends GS 110-132(a) to clarify that written affidavit of parentage is not an admission of paternity when affidavit limits its terms. Amends GS 131D-10.3A(b) (criminal checks of foster parents) to delete requirement that criminal histories of foster parents be checked annually. Reinstates GS 131D-10.6B and incorporates amendments made to that sec. into new GS 131D-10.6C. Reinstates GS 143B-150.20(h). Amends GS 143B-150.20(d) to establish deadline of 30 days for receipt of requested information and to provide that requests for order compelling disclosure may be filed in the district court in the county where investigation is being conducted (was, Wake County Superior Court). Amends GS 153A-257(d) by deleting provision making Director of the Division of Social Services' determination concerning which county dep't of social services is responsible for providing services binding upon dep'ts.
