S 510. SAFETY AT AUTOMATIC TELLER MACHINES. TO REQUIRE INCREASED CUSTOMER SAFETY MEASURES AT UNMANNED AUTOMATIC TELLER MACHINES. Amends GS 53-63(d1) (banks), GS 54B-77(a) (savings and loan associations) and GS 54C-146(a)(1) (savings banks) to authorize Comm'r of Banks to adopt rules concerning the safety of customers using automatic teller machines. Requires that by Oct. 1, 2003, Comm'r adopt temporary rules concerning customer safety, including the addition of barriers to motor vehicle intrusion upon customer areas and intercoms and other means for customers to call for emergency assistance.

S 510. SAFETY AT AUTOMATIC TELLER MACHINES. Intro. 3/24/03. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Deletes amendments to GS 53-63(d1), 54B-77(a), and 54C-146(a)(1). Adds new GS 53-62.1 requiring that State Banking Comm'n adopt rules applicable to automated teller machines that are located off-premises of the owner, freestanding, designed to be used by customers who are on foot, and located in a parking lot or exposed to vehicular traffic. Provides that rules adopted by Comm'n shall not apply to machines designed for use from customer's vehicle or to machines operated by credit unions. Adds new GS 54-109.11(6), incorporating requirements of GS 53-62.1. Modifies deadline for adoption of temporary rules to 180 days from effective date (was, Oct. 1, 2003) and provides that State Banking Comm'n and Administrator of Credit Unions shall adopt those rules (was, Comm'r of Banks) and deletes provision specifying those safety measures that must be included in rules.
