CLARIFY MV DEALER FRANCHISE LAWS. *TO CLARIFY THE MOTOR VEHICLE DEALER FRANCHISE LAWS.* Allows sale of a motor vehicle as "new" even though it has previously been sold, so long as the odometer mileage does not exceed 1,000 miles. Widens the area counted as "relevant market area" in GS 20-286 for purposes of deciding when a manufacturer can locate additional dealerships. Authorizes issuance of temporary licenses for sales of antique and specialty vehicles to licensed motor vehicle dealers. Expands protections for motor vehicle dealers from various actions of manufacturers, overriding provisions of franchise agreements.
