Adds new GS 66-58.5(c) to clarify that art. does not affect validity, presumptions, or burdens of proof concerning electronic signatures accepted pursuant to Ch. 66, Art. 40, or other laws. Amends GS 55-16-22 to authorize corporations to file annual reports in electronic form and to require that Sec'y of State prescribe form for those electronic reports. Authorizes Sec'y of State to study changes to the Notary Public Act that are necessary to facilitate electronic notarization and make recommendations to the 2004 Regular Session. Makes technical changes.
