Amends GS 50B-3(b) to provide that a court may renew a protective order for good cause, including an order that previously has been renewed, upon a motion by the aggrieved party filed before the expiration of the current order. States that no act of domestic violence need be committed by the defendant after entry of the current order in order for the order to be renewed.
