S 632. WORKERS' COMP./AGRICULTURAL EMPLOYMENT. *TO LOWER THE NUMBER OF AGRICULTURAL WORKERS THAT MUST BE EMPLOYED BY AN EMPLOYER IN ORDER FOR AGRICULTURAL EMPLOYMENT TO BE WITHIN THE PURVIEW OF THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION ACT.* Current law exempts agriculture services from GS 97-2(1) definition of "employment," and GS 97-13(b) provides that workers' compensation act is inapplicable to farm laborers when less than ten full-time nonseasonal workers are employed. Act removes these exemptions.
