**S 632. WORKERS' COMP./AGRICULTURAL EMPLOYMENT.** TO LOWER THE NUMBER OF AGRICULTURAL WORKERS THAT MUST BE EMPLOYED BY AN EMPLOYER IN ORDER FOR AGRICULTURAL EMPLOYMENT TO BE WITHIN THE PURVIEW OF THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION ACT. Current law exempts agriculture services from GS 97-2(1) definition of "employment," and GS 97-13(b) provides that workers' compensation act is inapplicable to farm laborers when less than ten full-time nonseasonal workers are employed. Act removes these exemptions.
