S 64. 2004 PRO TEM APPOINTMENTS BILL (NEW). Intro. 2/18/03. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Changes title to read *AN ACT TO APPOINT PERSONS TO VARIOUS PUBLIC OFFICES UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE AND TO MAKE VARIOUS CHANGES TO BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS.* As title indicates. Amends GS 143B-452(a) to increase the membership of the NC State Ports Authority from 11 to 13. Amends GS 143B-452(e) to delete the existing provision and replace it with a provision, effective July 1, 2004, that directs the General Assembly to appoint 6 members, 3 by the Speaker and 3 by the Pres. Pro Tem. Of each group of 3, 1 shall serve a term of 1 year, and 2 shall serve terms of 2 years. After the initial appointments, all terms shall be for 2 years. Amends GS 160A-480, concerning authorities, to provide that an authority shall have either 10 or 21 members, (now, 8 or 19). Amends GS 160A.3 to provide that 5 members (now, 4) shall be appointed by the Speaker and 5 by the Pres. Pro Tem.
