**S 686. RETIRED EDUCATORS RETURN TO WORK. TO ENABLE RETIRED EDUCATORS TO RETURN TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS WITHOUT LOSING RETIREMENT BENEFITS.** Amends GS 115C-325(a)(5a) and 135-3(8)c. to reduce period of time educators must be retired before they can be rehired without losing retirement benefits from six to two months, and to require that the person have been previously employed as a teacher, principal or assistant principal. Amends various session law currently in effect that allow such reemployment without loss of retirement benefits to remove the sunset provisions from those acts. Effective July 1, 2003.
