S 705. UNC- NONAPPROPRIATED CAPITAL PROJECTS. TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION AND FINANCING, WITHOUT APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND, OF CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS OF THE CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA. As title indicates; funding may come from gifts, grants, receipts, self-liquidating indebtedness, or other sources, but not from appropriations. Projects are: Appalachian State--athletic facilities, \$35.8 million; parking deck, \$ 5 million. East Carolina--residence halls, \$39.95 million. NC A & T--student union renovation, \$2.7 million. NC Central--parking deck, \$5 million. NC State--residence hall renovation, \$10 million; community center, \$2 million; student fitness center, \$12 million; Partners V building, \$18 million; theatre and music center, \$6 million; track, softball and soccer complex, \$1 million; Reynolds Coliseum, \$5 million. UNC Chapel Hill--Rizzo Center, \$18 million; McColl Building, \$18 million; Botanical Garden, \$6 million; Ackland Art Museum, \$16 million; printing services, \$3.5 million; ITS building, \$12.3 million; YMCA renovation, \$3.5 million; student family housing, \$30 million; Cobb dorm renovation, \$9.884 million; parking, \$19.2 million; infrastructure improvements and waste remediation, \$52 million, UNC Charlotte--student union, \$39.7 million; baseball stadium, \$3 million. UNC Greensboro--exercise track, \$1 million; residence hall renovation, \$3.3 million; university center library connector, \$1.5 million; Gove Health Center, \$8.5 million; softball field, \$3 million. Western Carolina--new residence hall, \$13.161 million; residence hall renovation, \$10.264 million; parking deck, \$6.25 million; cafeteria renovation, \$4.927 million; softball field and stadium, \$2.32 million. In addition, authorizes the following projects which may be financed by special obligation bonds issued by UNC Board of Governors: UNC Chapel Hill—Burnett-Womack Building, \$7.395 million; Beard Hall, \$2.394 million; science complex, \$8.854 million; Manning steam plant, \$ 13.212 million; international studies facility, \$5 million; Cogeneration-turbine improvements, \$24 million. UNC Pembroke--auxiliary services building, \$1.5 million; recreational facilities, \$.6 million. Authorizes UNC Chapel Hill to use lease arrangements with nonprofit corporations in Rizzo Center, Ackland Museum and family housing projects.
