S 714. COMPENSATION OF TEACHERS ON ACTIVE DUTY. ENSURE THAT TEACHERS DO NOT LOSE PAY WHILE THEY ARE ON MILITARY DUTY. Amends GS 115C-302.1 to add provision directing State Board of Education to adopt rules insuring that teachers in public or charter schools do not lose pay or time due to their taking a leave of absence for military service or special emergency management service. The rules must provide that state pays salary differential for teachers in state-funded positions, local board pays differential for locally funded teachers and charter school pays for its teachers, and local board pays for any local supplement needed to ensure that no pay loss takes place. Effective for school years beginning with 2002-03 school year.
