S 732. NEW URBAN WATERFRONT DEVELOPMENT PILOT (NEW). Intro. 4/3/03. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Completely rewrites bill so it now authorizes the Coastal Resources Comm'n to implement a pilot program under which a single "new urban waterfront area" may be designated for one county in state (the county must have a population density of not more than 150 people per square mile and must not border the ocean). The pilot area must be outside the limits of any municipality. Bill sets limits on drainage patterns permissible for waterway and sets standards to govern developers who may submit applications for a major development permit for development in the pilot area. Directs the Commission to report on the costs and benefits of the pilot area to the Environmental Review Comm'n annually. All portions of the act other than the reporting requirements expire July 1, 2010.
