S 736. EXPAND SCOPE OF HATE CRIMES. TO HONOR THE MEMORY OF MATTHEW SHEPARD BY EXPANDING THE SCOPE OF THE HATE CRIME LAWS AND INCREASING THE CRIMINAL PENALTY FOR COMMITTING A HATE CRIME. Amends GS 14-3(c) to increase punishment for misdemeanors committed because of victim's real or perceived race, color, religion, nationality, gender or gender expression, sexual orientation, disability, age, or country of origin (italicized language added). Adds new GS 14-3(d) to increase punishment for felonies committed because of victim's real or perceived race, color, religion, nationality, gender or gender expression, sexual orientation, disability, age, or country of origin. Amends GS 14-401.14(a) and GS 15A-1340.16(d)(17) to make them applicable to specified criminal acts based on victim's real or perceived race, color, religion, nationality, gender or gender expression, sexual orientation, disability, age, or country of origin (italicized language added). Effective Dec. 1, 2003; applies to offenses committed on or after effective date.
