Decreases maximum civil penalty from \$5,000 in original bill to \$2,000. Provides that no penalty shall be assessed unless person has been given written notice of violation and reasonable period of time in which to correct violation, except person is not entitled to reasonable period of time to correct violation before penalty is assessed when violation is likely to cause physical injury or illness. Provides that training and management practices implemented to comply with Article shall be a mitigating factor in assessing civil penalty. Provides that act applies to violations of Article occurring on or after date when act becomes law.
