S 867. ARSON/SERIOUS INJURY TO FIREFIGHTER. Intro. 4/3/03. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Amends GS 14-69.3 to make offense a Class E (was, Class D) felony.

July 16, 2003

S 867. ARSON-FIREFIGHTER INJURY/NEW BOMB OFFENSE (NEW). Intro. 4/03/03. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 3rd edition. Adds new GS 14-49(b2) making it a Class E felony to damage a public building with an explosive or incendiary device or material. Also establishes in Dept. of Crime Control & Public Safety, State Highway Patrol Division, the "Honorary Liston B. Ramsey Mounted Horse/Caisson Patrol Unit" to function as a horse-drawn caisson procession at the funeral services of law-enforcement personnel and fallen heroes and heroines; requires State Highway Patrol to assign two primary troopers to unit on receipt of sufficient funds to operate unit. New offense applicable to offenses committed on or after Dec. 1, 2003; new unit effective when act becomes law.

S 867. ARSON-FIREFIGHTER INJURY/NEW BOMB OFFENSE. Intro. 4/3/03. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 4th edition. Limits application of new GS 14-69.3 to injuries suffered by a firefighter while discharging or attempting to discharge duties on the property, or proximate to the property, that is the subject of the firefighter's duties.
