S 877. CHILD CARE FACILITIES/PENALTIES. Intro. 4/3/03. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Completely rewrites original bill so it now provides as follows: Rewrites GS 110-103 (criminal penalty) to provide that violation of GS 110-98 (mandatory compliance) is Class 1 misdemeanor. However, violations of GS 110-98(2), 110-99(b), 110-99(c), and 110-102 are exempted from this provision. Person who operates child care facility and (1) willfully violates GS 110-99(a) (display of license) or (2) willfully violates provision of Article while providing child care for more than two children, for more than four hours per day on two consecutive days, is guilty of Class I felony. Person who violates Article and, as result of violation, causes serious injury to child attending child care facility, is guilty of Class H felony. Amends GS 110-99 to provide that it is unlawful for child care facility to operate without current license for issuance under GS 110-88. April 30, 2003
