**S 93. AMEND SPECIAL PROBATION DEFINITION.** *TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF SPECIAL PROBATION TO REMOVE THE SIX-MONTH LIMITATION ON THE PERIOD OF IMPRISONMENT.* Amends GS 15A-1344(e) and GS 15A1351(a) to provide that any period of confinement required under special probation may not exceed one-fourth of the maximum sentence of imprisonment imposed for the offense (previously the period of confinement could be the lesser of either six months or one-fourth of the maximum sentence). Would apply to offenses committed on or after Dec. 1, 2003.
