Adds new GS 20-7(q) requiring DMV to develop a military designation for drivers licenses issued to NC residents on active military duty and their spouses and dependent children. Allows renewal by mail no more than twice, renewal up to one year prior to expiration upon presentation of military credentials, and waiver of vision test if licensee is deployed to combat zone or qualified hazardous duty zone.

Adds new GS 20-7(r) providing that a license holder who is a member of the national guard or a reserve unit shall be exempt from the eye exam when renewing a license if, at the time of renewal, the license holder is serving in a combat zone or a hazardous duty zone. Changes effective date from when the act becomes law to Jan. 1, 2004.
