S 936. WAIVE DEADLINES FOR TROOPS. TO WAIVE VARIOUS DEADLINES, FEES, AND PENALTIES FOR DEPLOYED MILITARY PERSONNEL. Generally authorizes the Governor to extend deadlines and waive penalties to alleviate hardship suffered by deployed military person (DMP) by (1) extending for 90 days the validity of drivers' licenses; (2) waiving penalties and fees for lapsed motor vehicle liability insurance up to 90 days after DMP returns; (3) allowing up to 90 days after end of deployment to renew an occupational license; and (4) requiring that any occupational license fees be prorated to reflect period of deployment. Allows up to 90 days after return for DMP to pay property taxes that became due during deployment. Allows 90 days after end of deployment to list property. Requires community colleges to grant full tuition refunds and buy back textbooks if DMP requests, and makes this service available to military reserve and national guard personnel called to active duty and active duty personnel who are reassigned. Allows constituent institutions of UNC system to grant full refunds of tuition and fees. Provides that students who receive the NC Legislative Tuition Grant but lose their full-time student status may not be required to repay the grant for the semester during which they are called up. Makes provisions that concern the community college system or the UNC system applicable only to the 2002-2003 and 2003-2004 academic years.
