Adds new GS 58, Art. 39, Part 3 "Personal Information Standards." Directs certain insurers to implement a comprehensive written information security program to safeguard personal information. Requires these insurers ("licensees") to identify threats that could result in unauthorized disclosure or destruction of information. Requires each affected licensee to establish an information security program, including appropriate policies, by Jan. 1, 2004.
