S 1. ADOPTION OF SENATE RULES. ADOPTING THE PERMANENT RULES OF THE SENATE FOR THE 2003 EXTRA SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY. Adopts the permanent rules of the 2003 Regular Session with the following significant exceptions: (1) no amendment concerning a redistricting bill may be offered on the floor unless that amendment was proposed in committee; (2) any amendment changing a redistricting plan must be accompanied by an analysis necessary to show compliance with *Stephenson v. Bartlett*; (3) no bills may be introduced or considered except those that deal with redistricting plans, election laws, laws related to the review of legislative districts, and laws relating to presidentially declared natural disasters; (4) bills reported by committee shall be placed before the Senate for second reading and immediate consideration upon passage; and (5) when a bill has passed second reading, it shall be placed on the calendar for immediate consideration on third reading, unless it is a revenue bill governed by Art II, sec. 23, NC Constitution.
