Requires that person seeking to use exemption must produce identification confirming person's membership in a State-recognized tribe upon the request of a wildlife enforcement officer. Requires that the Comm'n of Indian Affairs provide the Wildlife Resources Comm'n with a list of properties owned by tribes and requires that tribes post tribal land to give notice of tribe ownership.
