H 1093. AMEND ENVIRONMENTAL LAWS-1 (=S 1132). TO AMEND VARIOUS ENVIRONMENTAL LAWS TO: (1) AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSION FOR HEALTH SERVICES TO MODIFY THE INSPECTION SCHEDULE FOR ESTABLISHMENTS THAT PREPARE OR SERVE FOOD OR DRINK TO THE PUBLIC; (2) AUTHORIZE THE USE OF FUNDS FROM THE SPECIAL ZOO FUND FOR MARKETING PURPOSES; AND (3) PROVIDE THAT MEMBERS OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION ON SEAFOOD AND AQUACULTURE WHO ARE NOT REELECTED TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY COMPLETE THEIR TERM OF SERVICE ON THE COMMISSION. Identical to S 1132, introduced 3/24/05.

H 1093. MORATORIUM IMPOSED ON NEW LANDFILLS (NEW). Filed 3/31/05. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Deletes all substantive provisions of original bill and substitutes in the substantive provisions of S 1575 (*AN ACT TO IMPOSE A MORATORIUM ON THE CONSTRUCTION OF PERMIT APPLICATIONS AND ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF NEW LANDFILLS IN THE STATE AND TO DIRECT THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION TO STUDY ISSUES RELATED TO SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL IN ORDER TO PROTECT PUBLIC HEALTH AND THE ENVIRONMENT*). Makes changes in the substantive provisions of S 1575 regarding exceptions to the moratorium imposed by the bill so that the exceptions would apply to (1) modifications to permits for landfills issued on or before June 1, 2006; (2) permits for horizontal or vertical expansion of landfills permitted on or before June 1, 2006; (3) permits for construction of new landfills within facility boundaries identified in facility plans permitted on or before June 1, 2006; (4) permits to operate new landfills if the permit was issued on or before June 1, 2006; (5) permits for sanitary landfills used only to dispose of waste generated by a coal-fired generating unit owned or operated by an investor-owned utility; and (6) permits for sanitary landfills necessary to respond to an imminent hazard to the public health or a natural disaster.

H 1093. MORATORIUM IMPOSED ON NEW LANDFILLS. Filed 3/31/05. Senate amendment makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Directs that study called for by bill specifically include measures concerning formation of dangerous chemicals and gases in flood-prone landfill environments.
