H 1187. RESTRUCTURE PRIOR CRIM. RECORDS PTS. Filed 4/11/05. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Modifies the prior record levels for felony sentencing in GS 15A-1340.14(c) as follows: Level I is not more than 1 point (it had been not more than 2 points in the prior edition); Level II is 2-5 points (had been 3-6 points in prior edition); Level III is 6-9 points (had been 7-10 points in prior edition); Level IV is 10-13 points (had been 11-14 points in prior edition); Level V is 14-17 points (had been 15-18 points in prior edition); and Level VI is at least 18 points (had been at least 19 points in prior edition). Makes conforming changes to the felony sentencing grid. Changes effective date to December 1, 2006, and applies to all offenses committed on or after that date.
