Amends GS 113-291.1(d1) by providing that hunters training dogs during the closed season may do so (1) subject to conditions and restrictions contained in rules of the Wildlife Resources Commission; (2) only on land owned or leased by the dog trainer or upon which the trainer has written permission to train dogs; and (3) only using artificially propagated waterfowl and game birds. Directs the Commission to initiate rulemaking to implement provisions of the act to regulate dog training.
