H 1241. STATE LAW OFFICERS' 28-YEAR RETIREMENT. TO ALLOW A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE TEACHERS' AND STATE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO RETIRE WITH UNREDUCED BENEFITS ON OR AFTER THE OFFICER'S FIFTIETH BIRTHDAY AND AFTER COMPLETING TWENTY-EIGHT YEARS OF SERVICE. Enacts new GS 135-5(b20) as title indicates, effective for officers retiring on or after July 1, 2005. Also amends GS 143-166.41(c)(3), which requires the discontinuation of a special separation allowance paid to retired law enforcement officers when officer becomes reemployed by a State agency or department, to delete exception for officers who return to a position exempt from the State Personnel Act in an agency different from the agency from which officer retired. Makes conforming changes. Effective July 1, 2005.
