Authorizes (was, required) the Legislative Research Comm'n (was, the Dep't of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention) to study the sentencing of persons between the ages of 16 and 21 to determine whether the state should enact a youthful offender code and adds requirement that Comm'n study sentencing of persons between the ages of 13 and 18 who are subject to GS 7B-1604 (prosecution of juveniles as adults). Requires that Comm'n submit its final report to the 2007 General Assembly by January 31, 2007 (was, report due by March 1, 2006).
