H 1299. MOTOR VEHICLE REPAIRS/CLARIFY COST OF REPAIR. *TO CLARIFY WHAT THE COST OF REPAIR WORK CONSISTS OF WHEN DETERMINING WHETHER THE COST OF REPAIR WORK IS SUFFICIENT TO REQUIRE A MOTOR VEHICLE REPAIR SHOP TO PREPARE A WRITTEN REPAIR ESTIMATE.* GS 20-354(a) requires that motor vehicle repair shops must prepare a written estimate of costs when a repair job will exceed \$350. This bill amends the statute to specify that in determining whether the cost will exceed \$350, the costs of parts and labor for the repair work and any charges for necessary diagnostic work and teardown are to be included, but taxes and repair shop supplies or overhead and other extra services incidental to the repair work are not. Effective October 1, 2005, and applies to estimates made then or later.
