H 1394. TESTAMENTARY RECOMMENDATION OF GUARDIAN. TO ALLOW THE PARENTS OF AN INCOMPETENT ADULT WHO IS NOT MARRIED TO RECOMMEND A GUARDIAN FOR THAT ADULT BY WILL OR OTHER DOCUMENT. Enacts new GS 35A-1212.1 allowing a parent to recommend an individual for appointment of a guardian of the parent's unmarried child if the child has been adjudicated incompetent. Amends GS 35A-1214 to provide that such an individual is entitled to priority if a guardian is appointed. Provides that the clerk is not bound by a testamentary recommendation if the clerk finds that appointing a different guardian is in the ward's best interest. Allows clerk to waive bond requirements for a guardian appointed pursuant to GS 35A-1212.1 if will so provides and clerk finds that ward's best interest would be served by waiving bond requirements.
