H 1399. HERITAGE TOURISM FUNDS. *TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A HERITAGE TOURISM DEVELOPMENT OFFICER TO SERVE HALIFAX, WARREN, FRANKLIN, AND VANCE COUNTIES.* Appropriates \$50,000 for 2005-06 and \$50,000 for 2006-07 from General Fund to Dep't of Commerce as title indicates. Effective July 1, 2005.

H 1399. VARIOUS TRANSPORTATION/M.V. LAW CHANGES (NEW). Filed 4/20/05. House committee substitute deletes all provisions of 1st edition and replaces it with *AN ACT TO MAKE CHANGES TO THE MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS CONCERNING WEIGHING OF WOOD RESIDUALS AND EXEMPTION FROM REGISTRATION FOR CERTAIN AGRICULTURAL VEHICLES, AND TO AUTHORIZE AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS TO EXPEDITE TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS.* Now (1) amends GS 20-118(c)(15) to provide that the weight restrictions exception for vehicles carrying wood residuals applies to material originating from any site; (2) amends GS 20-51(6) to add all vegetables, fruits, greenhouse and nursery plants and flowers, and Christmas trees to the list of products that if carried by a farmer in a trailer or semitrailer exempt the trailer or semitrailer from registration and certificate of title requirements; and (3) adds new GS 136-66.8 to authorize the Department of Transportation to enter into interlocal agreements with units of local government to allow local governments to fund and complete State transportation projects on an expedited schedule if the projects are scheduled in the Department's Transportation Improvement Plan more than two years from the date of the agreement. Local governments receive full reimbursement from the State when the project comes due under the Transportation Improvement Plan.
